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## **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS OF SSS (2021-2022)**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Women's College, Agartala has conducted online Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on the teaching-learning process among the students of the college as a part of AQAR. 1375 online responses of students were received. The feedback analysis of the SSS highlights our strength and also makes us aware of the various aspects of teaching-learning process going on in the institution which deserve our attention. Regarding the coverage of syllabus, about 95 percent of the respondent students have opined that more than 55 percent of the syllabus was covered. 33.2 percent of the respondents have appreciated the preparedness of teachers with the remark 'Thoroughly' while 58.8 percent have opined 'Satisfactorily'. 56.2 percent respondent students have remarked that the teachers' ability to communicate was 'Always Effective' and 25 percent responded with the remark 'Sometimes effective' and 14.9 percent opined 'Just satisfactorily'. Regarding teacher's approach to teaching, the responses were mixed, 31.4 percent remarked 'excellent', 41 percent responded 'very good' and 24.8 percent mentioned 'Good'. 56.7 percent respondent students have applauded the fairness of the internal evaluation process and remarked it as 'Always fair', 29.7 percent have remarked it as 'Usually fair' and 11.4 percent remarked 'Sometimes Unfair'. Regarding discussion with the students about their performance in assignments and the parameters of teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitating their cognitive, social and emotional growth, provision of multiple opportunities by the institution to learn and grow, the responses of the students were diverse. Above 55 percent have expressed that teachers inform them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes 'Every time', while 26.5 percent have responded with the remark 'Usually' and remaining 1.4 percent remarked 'Occasionally'. 53 percentage of the respondent students have reported that the teachers illustrate the concepts with the practical examples and applications 'every time' while 30.3 percent mentioned percent remarked 'Occasionally/sometimes'. 50.5 percent 'Usually' and 12.5 remarked that the teachers 'Fully' identify their strength and encourage them to take up challenges, 33 percent of the respondent students 'Reasonably' agreed and 9.5 percent 'Slightly' agreed that teachers identify their strengths and encourage them. The efforts made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make respondent students ready for the world of work are appreciated to great extent by 44.9 percent respondent students. 80.4 percentage of the respondent students remarked that above 50 percent teachers use ICT tools, projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching. About 96.2 percent respondent students are satisfied with the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.
